## **POOL REPAIRS**

The Board met with Mr. Gutierrez, Majestic Landscape and Pool Maintenance who provided the board and management with three bid proposals for repairs to the pool. After reviewing and discussing all three proposals, the board unanimously voted, 5 Yeas-0 Nays, for C&R Pool Plastering to do the repairs, with an estimated start date (ESD) of June 21, 2012 and an estimated completion date (ECD) of July 31, 2012. After the pool repairs are complete it will take another 1 1/2 weeks to prepare the pool for swimming, (e.g. fill the pool with water, chemically treat it...etc). The pool will remain closed while repairs are being conducted. Expenses for this project is considered a capital improvement/repair project and therefore will not require assessments from the membership, but instead, monies will be withdrawn from EG's Capital Reserve Replacement Account, for this reason, why monies are deposited monthly into this account. Below is an approximate brief summary of pool repair costs and scope of work:

- Obtain permits/draft letter to HUD
- Drain pool/demo-strip old plaster
- Undercut waterline tile and all pool fixtures
- Replace back-row transition tile
- Install handrail/recessed steps & metal bar
- New rope anchors/install 3 channel drains/skimmer aux.
- Finish plaster/depth markers
- Install new filter system
- Clean existing coping tile
- Estimated cost \$10,800.00

## Estimated Start Date: June 21, 2012 Estimated Completion Date: July 31, 2012

- Keep clear and observe all closed-off areas while work is being performed, (e.g. taped or roped areas).
